

# Questions for Growth Groups to apply the word of Psalm 21 to our hearts:

What struck you as Psalm 21 was preached?

What is God saying to *us* at Trinity today?

Where do we find ourselves looking to for salvation/deliverance other than Jesus?

- What do those things promise that only Jesus can truly deliver?

## **Rejoicing in the King's Victory (1-7)**

Which of the blessings of vs1-7 most encourages you? Why?

What difference does the future victory make to how we experience sufferings / sin today? You may wish to look at 1 Peter 1:3-9.

- You may wish to share what your present struggles are.

What would it look like for us to encourage each other to fix our eyes on this joy to come?

## **Judgement on God's Enemies (8-13)**

What emotions or questions do verses 8–12 raise for you?

Why is the defeat of God's enemies' good news for us?

Psalm 21 is a Psalm calling us to rejoice spend some time praising the Lord for the victory of Jesus over Sin, Satan and death, and thanking him for the blessings that flow from him.
